

## **Condition reports**

- 1) When buying or selling a boat/yacht, we recommend a comprehensive survey of its condition, as a result of our many years of experience. The boat/yacht should be surveyed at its mooring in the port, on land and during a sea trial. The scope of the survey is determined in consultation with the client. The results can be communicated to the client in the form of a verbal purchase consultation, a list of deficiencies or a complete survey report.
- 2) When a boat/yacht is put into service for the first time, we take over the final acceptance and report the results in a list of deficiencies.
- 3) In the event of construction defects, the survey report serves to acknowledge warranty claims against the shipyard.

## **Valuation reports**

Insurers and banks often demand value appraisals from their clients. The commissioned surveyor then checks the condition of the boat/yacht and determines its market value. When the market value of a boat/yacht is assessed, not only good knowledge of the current market situation but also experience is very important.

## **Expertise for Swiss Yacht Register**

The Swiss Maritime Navigation Authority (SSA) requires an expertise of the suitability of the yacht for deep-sea navigation with/without restrictions in order to register the vessel in the Swiss Yacht Register. During an inspection, the expert checks the condition of the yacht and its safety equipment.
